We are hoping to welcome some new friends into our tribe, so herewith the usual stuff, followed by camp specific details:

AMENITIES AVAILABLE:

- **Lapa** with patio seatings, a kitchen area, a fridge and freezer, washing-up basins, a 2-plate gas stove.
- **Ablutions:** Toilets and showers & basins with hot water
- **Electricity** points for camp sites. Bring a long lead
- **Hot tub:** small tub with wood-fired donkey for which WCNA will contribute the wood
- Fire Pit
- 2 Chalets
- The river



BRING ALONG:

- Sunblock / Suntan Lotion
- Towel to sit on
- Braai wood

CAMP LAY-OUT:

- Please consider other campers when pitching your tent or parking your camper. Allow for sufficient space for everyone around you.
- If you do not utilise your vehicle for camping, kindly move it to the parking area.

TARIFFS:

- Members: R190 per person per night
- Non-members: R250 per person per night
- Pensioners: R140 per person per night*
- Children 3 - 13yrs: R130 per child per night
- Children under 3yrs: Free

- Chalet: R350 per person per night**
- Day Visitors: R90 per person per day

* *Kindly note that this discounted tariff for pensioners applies to members only and do not include staying in the chalets.*

***There are only 2 chalets at this site. Kindly check availability with Jullian before making a payment.*

Wolvenberg is in the Rawsonville district.

- . Once out of Rawsonville, from Van Riebeeck Street (Main Road), turn in at Goudini Wines (GOUDYN road).
- . Follow the narrow tar road to the end where it makes a 90 degree turn in front of a gate.
- . Do not go through the gate. Stay on the road.
- . The road runs into a farm house.
- . Take the dirt road to the right side of the farm house, and look out for the camp site direction boards.
- . On your route you will see on your right, workers housing and then a big dirt dam wall.
- . On your left Blue Gum trees (Bos Camp) pass that and follow the boards that says *Wolvenberg Kloof camp*, to the right up the kloof.

SAFETY AND PRIVACY:

The WCNA banner will be up at the entrance, ensuring that visitors who inadvertently pay us a visit know what to expect! Lizelle will be the official photographer, with Carl as back-up. Content will only be taken and published with consent.



WEEKEND PROGRAM:

FRIDAY

- **Check-in time:** From 14h00
- **Meet-and-greet** at the lapa, from 18h00: Let's start the weekend in high spirits, by all contributing a Beerfest-inspired Brotzeit platter to share. It literally translates to "bread time".
- Think sourdough or rye bread/sausages/pickles/jams/spreads/cheese/fruit/nuts ...whatever makes you yodel!
- **Supper plans:**
All are still welcome to do our own supper thing on Friday evening, though the welcome platters seem to have become the star of the meet-and-greet evenings!



SATURDAY

- 10h30 – 11h30: **Admin Hour** at the lapa.
Every family / group / person attending the camp is requested to check in with Jullian and Carl, even if you've paid via EFT. This is really important, as we need to pay over the correct amount to the camp site owner.
- **Communal braai** at the lapa, from 16h00: Dress up, or down, for a night of Oompah music and dance.
- **Menu:** We suggest including some German sausage in your braai - for a German roll! **WCNA will provide rolls, butter, mustard, potato salad and dessert.**
- **Party toppers**
Do bring enough cash. Assortment of German caned beers will be sold at the camp.

If the site is booked for the Monday, we can either depart early, or ask for permission for the possibility to clear the camp site, and then braai and kuier up the river for the rest of the day.
